Arriving at the Kalahari:

Official Check in at the resort is 4:00 PM. Although your room MAY be available earlier, plan to leave your luggage in the car if you arrive before 4:00 PM. **Parking is FREE at the Kalahari.**

On SUNDAY, June 6th ONLY, from 2:00- 8:00 PM Satellite Hotel Check in for THSADA Attendees will be open in the **Convention Center**. Park at the Convention Center Entrance and avoid the crowds in the lobby!

If you are not arriving Sunday, you will check in at the main front desk in the main part of the hotel

All guest rooms are equipped with a microwave, refrigerator, iron, ironing board, in-room safe, complimentary Wi-Fi, remote control television with cable, alarm clock, voice mail system, hair dryer, luxurious bath amenities and admission to the waterparks.
